Intent of expenditure for academic year 2016/17:

- Daily lunchtime sports provided by external company 'Arsenal Sports Coaching'.
- Teacher insets on specific areas to help develop the quality of teaching (KS1/2: basic ball skills, invasions games, football, athletics and dance. Foundation Stage: introduction to PE and to learn basic fundamental skills) – delivered by 'Arsenal Soccer School'
- Free after school Games Club to increase PE and Sport participation across the school (Arsenal Sports Coaching).
- Continuation of swimming provision for children from Reception – Year 6
- Sports equipment purchases/upgrades.
- Gifted and talented opportunities – developing those children who show a particular aptitude to sport.

How has the PE and Sport Premium grant made a difference to our school?

We are continuing to work closely with one of the leading PE and sports coaching companies, Arsenal Soccer School, to raise the level of achievement reached by pupils as well as working alongside teachers to increase their subject knowledge and confidence.

Teachers have, and will continue, to benefit from numerous training on a range of sports helping them to develop their PE and sports skills which in return has enhanced and developed the children's learning in these sessions.

Increase in participation of sport during after school clubs. Children continue to enjoy the opportunity to take part in various free after school clubs delivered by Arsenal Soccer and school staff. Children relish the opportunity to take part in free after school clubs delivered by an external organisation 'Arsenal Soccer School'. Being able to provide a free 'Arsenal' football club for all years has been extremely popular and club sizes have increased. It is great to see the increased participation throughout the school.

Daily lunchtime activities set up by Arsenal Soccer and school playleaders has been extremely popular with the children helping to achieve more PE and sport participation. Activities vary offering a range of events for all abilities and ages.

We offer high quality swimming provision for all children across the school, with each class continuing to have their statutory 3 x hours of lessons per year. We have managed to secure extra swimming slots/instructors at Newton Abbot Leisure Centre Swimming Pool which are reserved for our children that require additional support with their water confidence. Also the PE and Sport premium fund has helped finance transport costs to

and from the swimming pool. This is supplemented by the school budget in order to give parents every opportunity for the children to take part swimming at no cost.

Children who have a particular sporting talent are offered extra opportunities to take part in training and competitions. The federation has a designated Gifted and Talented Co-ordinator for this purpose.

Sporting equipment is being continually updated making sure that high quality equipment is available for all classes to use.
