### ONLINE LEARNING

During these difficult times, we are aware that children may be absent from school due to Covid 19 related illness/symptoms.

However, we understand that many of our absent pupils will not be poorly or displaying symptoms themselves, but they may have to be at home because of siblings/parents/carers displaying symptoms. The Government guidance has asked us to ensure that remote learning is in place and we will therefore be providing work to any pupils who are at home self-isolating/waiting for a test.

The work will be reflective of what is going on each day in children's classrooms. It will be uploaded for the week onto **Google Classroom** for children to access at home.

- The week's work will be uploaded to Google Classroom on a **TUESDAY**
- The daily activities will be in a weekly grid and the sheets/videos/activities will be attached
- The work can either be completed online or in a work book (please ask Mrs Arnold or Mrs Harding if you require a workbook)
- Work will be marked when handed in, either online or in the workbook
- A check in phone call will be made to the family
- Staff can be contacted via email if needed – please remember they will be teaching during the day

This is how we propose home learning will operate for this academic year. If the Year group bubble closes due to a child/staff member testing positive for Covid 19, there will be a letter informing you of how learning will take place.
