USF School Uniform Policy

All children are expected to wear school uniform. Sweatshirt colours differ depending on the school e.g.

St. Michael's – blue,

St. Catherine's – green,

St. Mary's – blue,

Marldon – red,

Ipplepen – blue,

Stokeinteignhead – blue,

Doddiscombsleigh – red

Our school uniform is:-

- School sweatshirt (or sweat cardigan) **with school/Federation logo** (or Froglets logo for Nursery children at St. Michael's). These are required uniform and need to be purchased from the school office.

All other items of uniform must be in school colours but can be purchased either with a logo from the school office or without a logo from any shop/supplier.

- Marldon School -Red or white polo Shirt
- Stokeinteignhead School- yellow polo shirt
- Other schools' white polo shirt or white short sleeved shirt.

All schools:

- Grey/black shorts/trousers/skirts/pinafore dress.
- Nursery children may also wear black/blue jogging bottoms.
- Children can wear gingham dresses in the summer term (school colour as mentioned above).
- School shoes must be worn to school. These can be black/brown sensible shoes, not trainers. But at break and lunchtimes children can wear trainers for running around.
- In the summer children can wear sandals which support their feet and have a back on them.

Optional uniform, with logo's, including T shirts/polo shirts, reversible coats, fleeces, woolly hats, baseball caps and school book bags are also available from the school office.

PE KIT

Currently, schools ask that PE Kit is worn to school on PE days.
Uniform should be plain or have a school logo.

- St. Michael's, St. Mary's, Marldon and Stokeinteignhead-white t-shirt/polo shirt
- St. Catherine's yellow t-shirt ,
- Ipplepen t-Shirt in team colour,
- Doddiscombsleigh red polo Shirt.

- Plain black shorts or navy (navy for children at Stokeinteignhead)
- Plimsolls or trainers (younger children need to have Velcro fasteners).
- A tracksuit should be worn in cold weather- these should be plain in black or navy blue (children at Stokeinteignhead should wear navy blue)

Swimming – children will need a swimming bag and towel.
Boys will need plain swimming trunks or fitted swimming shorts.
Girls will need a plain swimming costume.

NOTES

- Children are not to wear nail varnish or make up to school.
- Children with long hair need to have their hair tied back during the school day for health and safety reasons.
- Children's hair must not be dyed.
- Children can wear watches.
- For Health and Safety reasons, the only jewellery that will be permitted in school is stud earrings for pierced ears. These are to be restricted to one stud per ear and must either be removed or taped for PE and Games.

Sun Safe

During the summer months the children are encouraged to bring a hat and sun cream, (which they can apply themselves). Parents might consider using 'day-long' sun cream which can be applied before school. Sun cream must be of a high factor to protect their skin.

All clothing must be named so that if lost it can be returned to its owner. Thank you .
