This term we are going to be looking at *Geography* and where we could build a city. To facilitate and support your children's learning, please use this overview sheet.

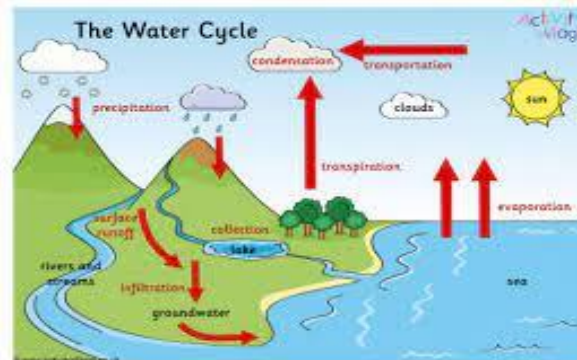
### As Scientist's we will:

- compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases
- observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C)
- identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.
- develop our skills in scientific investigation

- Remember new language using picture, word and phrases cards.
- Improve gist reading and gist listening skills.
- Attempt to re-tell a familiar fairy tale in French using a mini book for support.
